



ABOUT THE PROGRAMME

GB Maxibasketball is a World and European championship medal-winning programme, founded in 2017/18 and supported by every home nation basketball governing body. Catering for high-level male and female players aged 35+ and older, the programme is a recognised part of the Basketball England Talent Pathway and operates within governing body protocols for national teams.

In 2026, ten GB squads competed at the FIMBA European Maxibasketball Championship in Athens, returning with two medals, and the GB Men's 50+ made history at the inaugural FIBA Masters Open. The programme now prepares for the 2026/27 season and the FIBA Masters Open 2027 cycle.

OUR AMBITION

To provide players with a high-quality platform to continue playing basketball and competing at performance level through regular training and international events.

OUR VISION

Official governing body representative masters teams winning medals at European and World Maxibasketball Championships.

A VOLUNTARY PROGRAMME — WHAT THAT MEANS

All GB Maxibasketball roles are voluntary. Staff and players self-fund their participation in training and at international competition, including travel and accommodation. Some material costs are covered for sports science and medicine staff (e.g. therapeutic strapping and first aid equipment).

In return, we offer something money rarely buys: hands-on experience in a national performance programme, structured professional development built on our growth mindset ethos, mentoring from experienced practitioners, and membership of GB Maxibasketball delegations at designated international championships (FIBA or any other recognised international body whose competitions further our competitive aspirations).

THE ROLE

The Team Manager is the organisational anchor of a GB Maxis squad, ensuring players and coaches can focus on performance. Each squad has a designated Team Manager, whose appointment is coordinated by the Training Camp Coordinator as Lead Team Manager.

Reports to	Training Camp Coordinator (Lead Team Manager)
Works with	Squad Head Coach, players, SSEM team and championship organisers
Term	Two years (2026/27–2027/28), subject to annual review
Commitment	Squad training camps and preparation events, plus the designated championship with the squad

RESPONSIBILITIES

SQUAD ORGANISATION

- Act as the primary communication link between squad players, coaches and the wider programme
- Manage squad administration: registration, kit sizing for orders, availability and travel details
- Coordinate squad logistics at camps and preparation events
- Provide confidential support for players and staff
- Support the Head Coach with scheduling of team meetings and sessions

CHAMPIONSHIPS

- Manage the squad's daily game and transport schedule, communicated to players and staff in good time
- Support the coach and players with all game-day preparation, including confirming the roster with table officials
- Ensure the SSEM team is made aware of emerging injuries, in concert with the coaching staff
- Liaise with championship organisers, the Lead Team Manager and delegation staff
- Manage kit, equipment and team administration in competition
